Subject: Proposals to extend Grange Top Quarry, Ketton

Dear Stakeholder

Earlier this year we held a public drop-in event to set out our proposals to extend Grange Top Quarry and sought feedback on our plans.

Since this consultation closed, we have reviewed all the feedback received and carried out some further studies. We have also developed a [Response Document](#) which provides more information on the key issues local people raised with us and highlights where adjustments have been made to our plans. Updated proposed mineral extraction plans and a number of 3D visualisations from points around the site showing how these locations will look at key stages in our project are also available to view via the website.

Our proposals to extend Grange Top quarry's extraction area will ensure the supply of raw materials and the long-term future of the adjacent cement works. The plans have been developed to ensure that they enhance nature and mitigate impact on our neighbours. They will also provide transformative improvements to footways and bridleways as well as a new Ketton works access road which will reroute HGV traffic away from the villages of Ketton and Tinwell.

The next step for us will be to submit a full application to Rutland County Council (RCC), which we expect to do in the coming weeks. RCC will then consult with statutory bodies and invite comments from residents before making its decision.
