#### **EDITH WESTON ACADEMY ROAD SAFETY AND TRAFFIC SURVEY**

## **Parent and Guardian Responses**

11-07-23

Thank you to all whom contributed to the Road Safety and Traffic Survey.

Of the 62 recipients of the survey, emailed by the school 09-05-23, 31 responded + 1 submitted without answering any of the questions (– perhaps in error).

All responses have been collated and can be viewed in **APPENDIX I** – Responses to Questions 1 to 3; 5 to 14 and 16 in chart form as well as **APPENDIX II** – Responses to Questions 4 and 15 as word clouds.

### **SUMMARY OF RESPONSES**

- 55% of respondents live in Edith Weston, including St George's Barracks;
- 71% said they travelled to school by car; with 19% by walking and 19% by bicycle. Multiple responses were possible to allow for those who used different methods;
- Whilst the majority neither felt safe or unsafe on their journeys to and from school, they were of the opinion (90%) that most drivers do not abide by the speed limit of 30mph on Manton Road and 87% thought that some form of traffic calming is required;
- With regard to what traffic calming measures should be employed (again, more than one option could be chosen) "Road Humps...." were chosen by 78% of the respondents and "Chicanes" and "Flashing 20mph signs" were equally selected by 48%;

- 65% of respondents knew that Weston Road has a speed limit of 20mph and 73% thought that the traffic calming measures on this road were effective;
- Overwhelmingly, 87% of people agreed that the school is not adequately sign posted to approaching traffic;
- 83% though that it was difficult to find a car parking space at drop off / pick up time whilst 65% responded that they did not feel their child was safe when walking from the car to the school grounds;
- 64% of Grown Ups would not allow their child of year 5 and 6 age to travel to school by themselves due to the perceived dangers;
- Finally, 40.63% of respondents confirmed that they had reported a car parking or road safety issue to someone be it a member of school staff, governor, parish council or RCC;

#### CONCLUSIONS

The vast majority of respondents agreed that traffic calming measures are needed to be employed on Manton Road in order to reduce the dangerous speeding issues that are more than evident on the Route to School.


The idea of Flashing 20mph signs during school arrival and departure times is seen very much as a secondary solution, with most respondents citing Road Humps as being the most desirable solution.

Generally there is an overwhelming call for the school to be better sign posted as a traffic calming measure in itself.








